Since 2019, I have been a Visiting Lecturer at the University of Westminster (London), co-tutoring Design Studio 18 (a Master Degree in Architecture). As a design tutor, I develop briefs, presentations and guide each individual student (with design & technical advice) to develop unique, cohesive and rich project narratives & architectural proposals. The studio's ethos is focused on climate change, data/computational design, and advanced design representation techniques. My specialisms lie in experimental computational fluid dynamic simulation software (Autodesk CFD) & other visual computational tools (such as 3D scanning/Photogrammetry, Grasshopper & Rhino) to help visualize and understand the principles of flux, performance, and scale of various ruptures of matter, energies & thermal systems.

Over the years I have have been invited to multiple pannels to comment & critique, at both Undergraduate & Postgraduate levels at the University of Westminster, the University of Tennessee & TU Einhoven. I am an active member of *Fieldworks - Anthropocene Teaching Practices*, a digital platform curated by Lidia Gasperoni, in cooperation with Chair of Architectural Theory (TU Berlin). My work has been published in *Monsoon Assemblages*, a research project lead by Professor Lindsay Bremner; My dissertation has been presented & published as part of 'Architectures, Natures & Data: The Politics of Environments' conference held at the Tallinn Faculty of Architecture.

I am fully qualified, UK Registered Architect (ARB - 094629J) with over 6 years of experience having previously worked in various architectural practices in the United Kingdom, Mauritius and Bahrein. 
